



INSTRUCTIONS

Formal challenging of the domain name

Anyone may challenge domain names assigned in use to third parties through the Registry. The complainant sends to the Registry a registered letter with return receipt containing the complainant's details, the challenged domain name, the reasons for dispute, the damage suffered or the rights he/she deems damaged. The letter must be addressed to:

The formal disputation of the domain name is mandatory and it is a compulsory pre-requirement to start the Re-Assignment Procedure: only challenged domain names can be object of the Re-Assignment Procedure.
