



INSTRUCTIONS

Selection of experts

If the complainant does not request the appointment of a board of three experts, the Dispute Resolving Service (DRS) Tonucci & Partners will provide a single-member board composed of only one expert, selected from the List of Experts assembled by the Body.

If the complainant requests instead that the controversy is resolved by a board of three experts, the Dispute Resolving Service (DRS) Tonucci & Partners nominates experts for the Party, one selected among names indicated by the complainant and the other selected among names listed by the defendant. The third expert, in all cases, is nominated by the Dispute Resolving Service (DRS) Tonucci & Partners, which selects a name out of five candidates (included in the List of Experts) presented before the two Parties. The selection among the five candidates is made with an effort to meet the preferences of each member of the two Parties. From the moment of receiving the above list, each member has five days to specify his or her preference.

The board is considered composed when the Dispute Resolving Service (DRS) Tonucci & Partners receives acceptance of the nomination by the expert in the case of a single-member board or by the third expert in the case of a board composed of three experts.

Once the board is composed, the nominees and the date in which the decision will be made will be communicated to the Parties.
